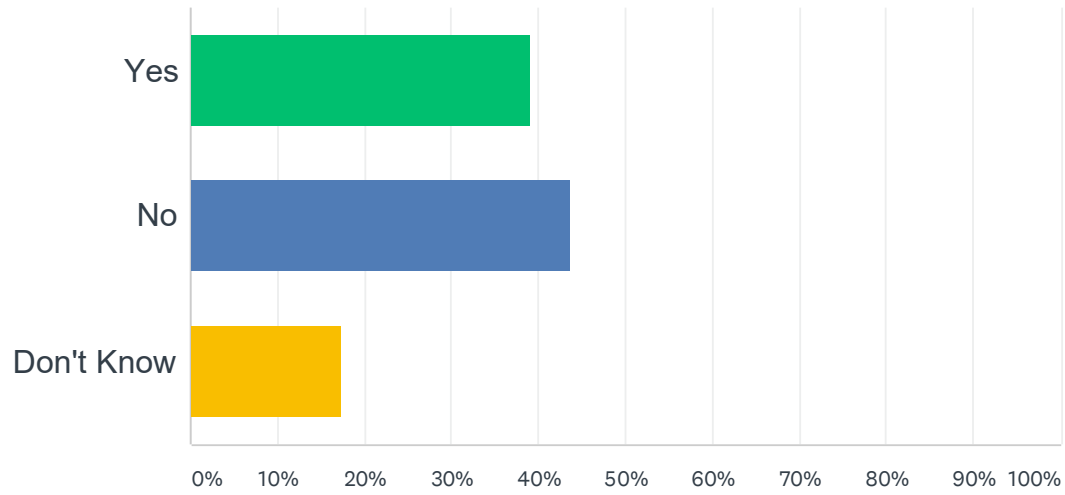
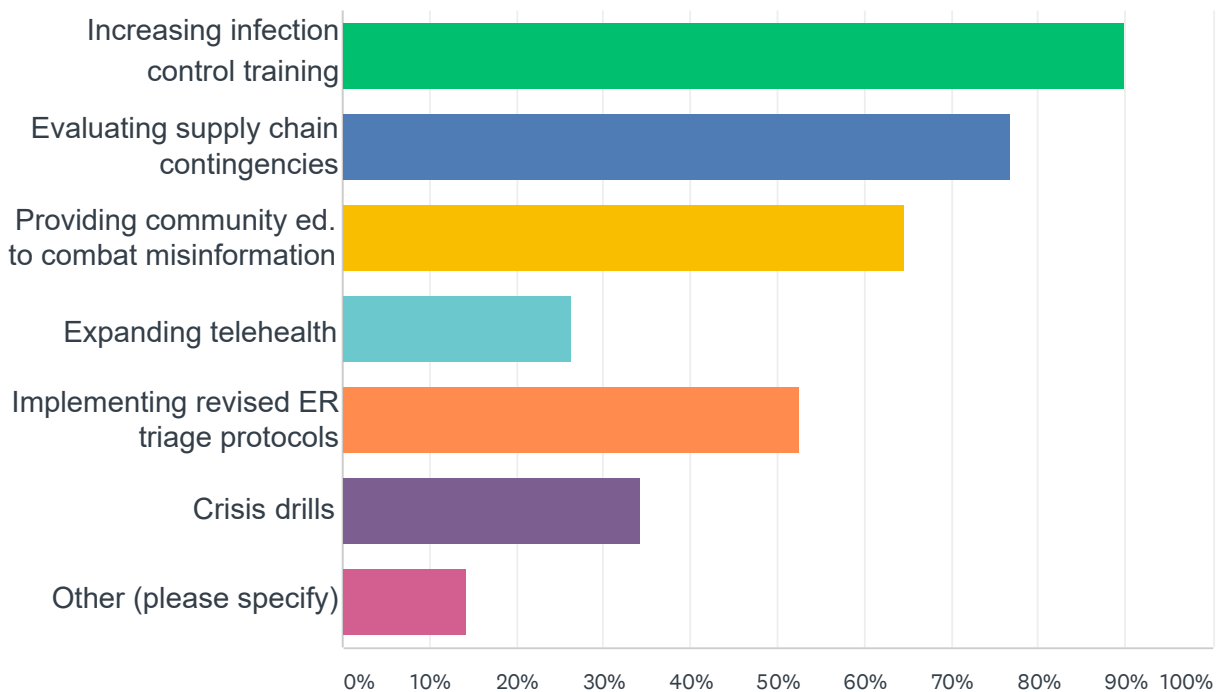


## Q1 Is the U.S. Health Care System prepared for COVID-19?



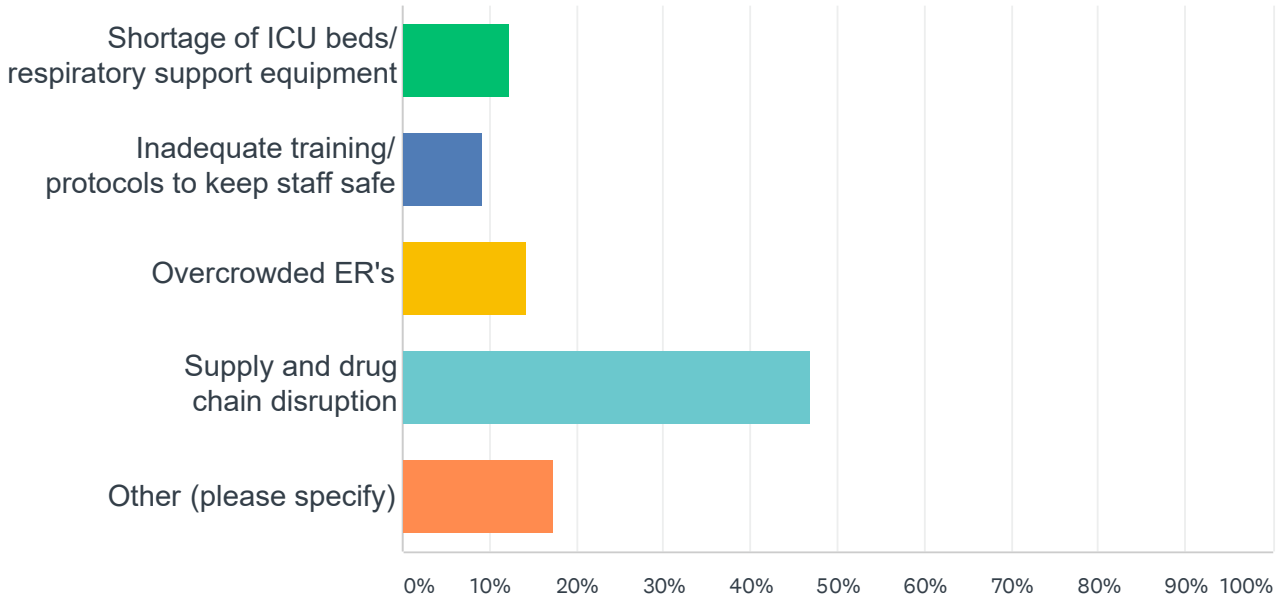

## Q2 What steps has your organization taken to prepare? [Select all that apply]



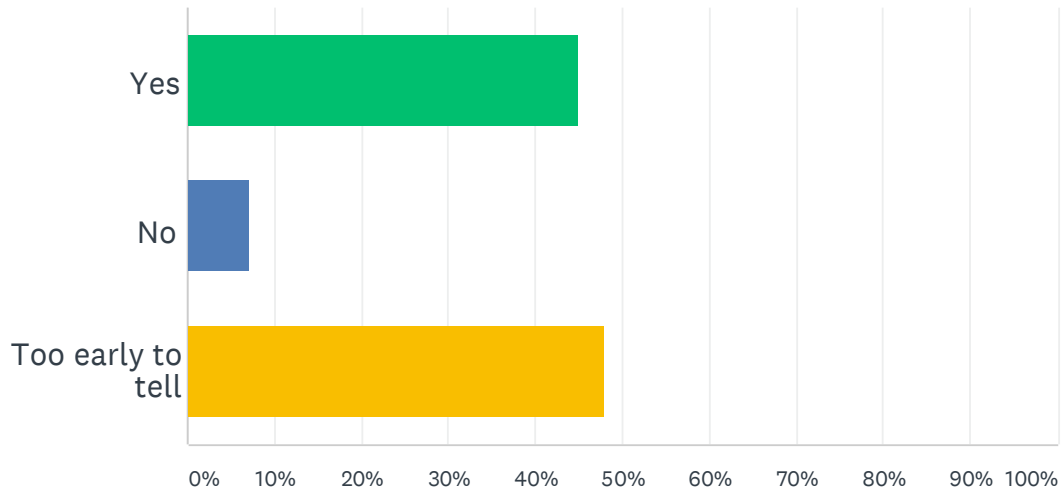

### Q3 What issue concerns you the most?



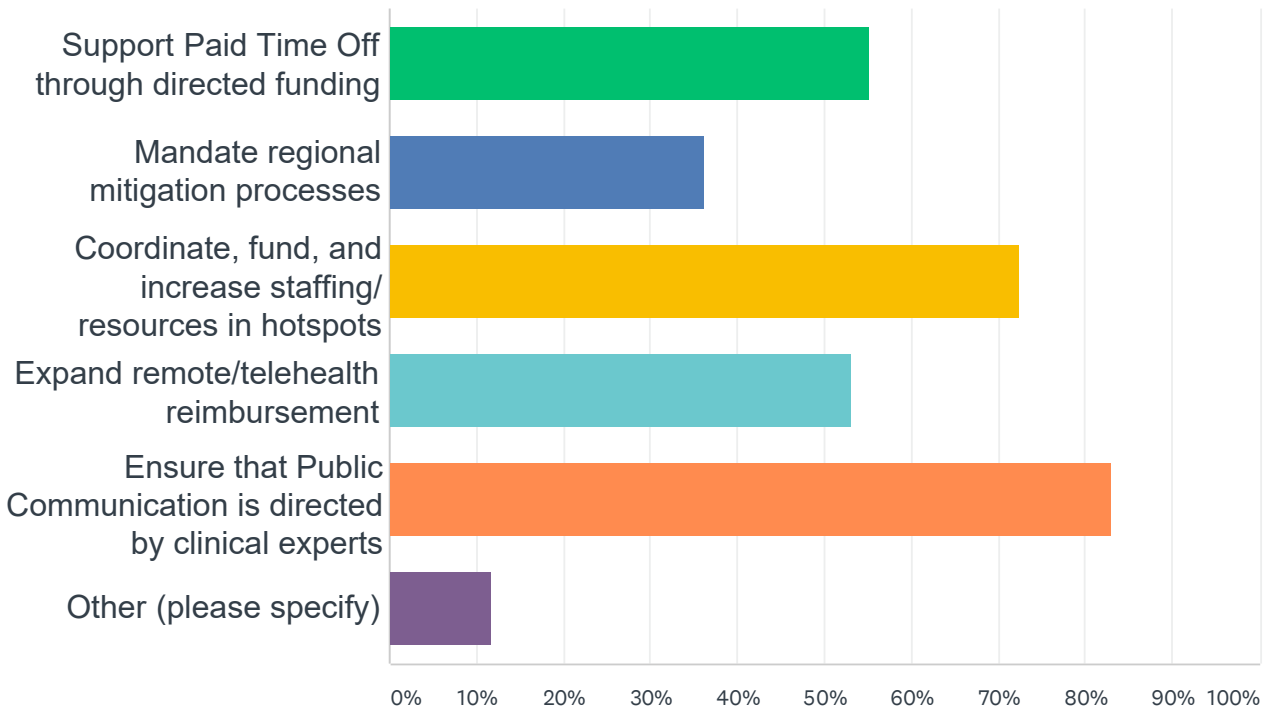
